



For the attention of the CEC:

I am writing to you in my capacity as Chair of the Belfast Constituency Council to advise you of a number of decisions taken by the Constituency Council this week.

1. The Belfast Constituency Council no longer recognises the suspension of the seven members of the Northern Ireland Business Committee. The Constituency Council supports the Northern Ireland Business Committee as the democratically elected Northern Ireland Regional Executive of the Workers Party and will resume work with the NIBC with immediate effect.
2. The Belfast Constituency Council is responsible for the co-ordination of Branch activity in Belfast, for the extension of Party membership in the area and for the establishment and monitoring of new Party Branches.
3. The Belfast Constituency Council does not recognise the so-called "Andersonstown Branch" or "Lower Falls/Grosvenor Cumann" as legitimate Branches of the Workers Party.
4. Party members and Party Branches in Belfast will provide the appropriate details of individual and Branch registration to the Belfast Constituency Council and these details will be held by me as Chair of the Constituency Council. Party members and Party Branches elsewhere in Northern Ireland will provide the appropriate details of individual and Branch registration to the Northern Ireland Business Committee and these details will be held by the Chair and Secretary of the NIBC.
